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ABOUT MY WORK

I create my works with the canvas flat on the floor and combine vibrant colours in a seemingly chaotic and spontaneous fashion, manipulating the surface of the canvas, building layer upon layer over a number of weeks. Pouring, washing, brushing and using a range of tools and techniques as I merge numerous vivid colours and constantly work the canvas. I allow the paint a certain amount of freedom, to interact and separate as I manipulate and build harmonious and expansive landscapes.

Through my painting I seek to express emotion and energy in a tangible form, creating works that are vibrant, full of movement and light, and inject a sense of life into the environment that becomes their home.

As my works have been created from all four sides, they can often be hung horizontal or vertical, whichever way is preferred by the viewer and suited to the hanging space, and by simply changing the way they're hung gives a new perspective.

My goal is to create powerful and beautiful works that completely engage, captivate and continue to inspire at every viewing. In creating my works I sincerely hope that purchasers gain as much enjoyment and love of the works, as I input into their creation.
